Please keep a supply of pencils, paper, pens, glue sticks, and markers at home. They need to be replenished several times throughout the year.

(Please use a permanent marker to write your child's name on appropriate items.)

Art Supplies:

- ❖ Package of construction paper
- ❖ Scissors
- ❖ Water colors
- ❖ Colored pencils
- ❖ Crayons (Markers are okay as an addition, but the crayons and pencils are needed)
- ❖ Glue stick
- ❖ Large tee shirt or apron to be labeled and kept in school

Math Supplies:

- ❖ Graph paper with reinforced holes (It will be used daily)
- ❖ Two sharpened pencils / pencil erasers
- ❖ Pencil sharpener that holds the shavings
- ❖ Protractor
- ❖ Compass
- ❖ White board markers: These are used almost daily
- ❖ White board eraser
- ❖ Calculator (Texas Instruments - TI-30XIIS - \$15 at Wal-Mart)

Bible Supplies:

- ❖ Bible (Amplified version if possible)
- ❖ Bible notebook that is a standard size (not something small like a notepad)

Language/Literature/Vocabulary Supplies:

- ❖ Notebook that is a standard size where pages are **not** to be torn out
- ❖ Two inch binder with pockets for handouts and assignments (with dividers for each of these three courses)
- ❖ Plenty of wide rule loose leaf paper with reinforced holes
- ❖ **Erasable** pens: blue, black, and red (Please, no white out)
- ❖ Small index cards with lines on one side

Science and Geography Supplies:

- ❖ Two inch binder with dividers for the two courses
- ❖ There will be several projects throughout the year: Magazines, newspaper, poster board, should be kept on hand. Most science experiments will use regular household items.
